We have a wide selection of new and classic DVD's including many TV series from premium channels, documentaries, and nonfiction as well as a collection suitable for younger and older children. DVD's go out for one week (new releases go out for 3 days).

We currently subscribe to 90 popular magazines, many of which may be borrowed and read leisurely at home. The Library also subscribes to THE RECORD, THE NEW YORK TIMES and THE WALL STREET JOURNAL.

## **BCCLS**

BCCLS (pronounced BUCKLES) is a federation of 77 libraries offering over 12 million books and other library resources to their Library patrons. The cornerstone activity of BCCLS has been, and remains, reciprocal borrowing, where a patron's hometown library card is honored at all participating libraries. All of the county's public libraries are members of BCCLS along with 15 libraries from neighboring counties.

As part of the BCCLS system, your Harrington Park Library card allows you to check out material from any BCCLS member library either in person or through the computer. Items borrowed from other libraries are delivered through the daily delivery service, usually in 3-5 days. Material borrowed may be returned to any member library. Harrington Park's BCCLS membership entitles you access to many databases and services including:

**ZINIO**, a free on-line magazine database offering over 200 of the most popular titles. Read on a tablet, PC or smartphone. You just need your library card and the app! Do you love magazines, if so then you'll love ZINIO! There are...No check out limits...No returns...No hold lists

**HOOPLA**, a digital collection of over 200,000 streaming and downloadable movies, TV shows, music, and audiobooks that you can access on your computer or download to a portable device. All titles are always available: No need to reserve!

**DOWNLOADABLE EBOOKS** and eAudiobooks for use on various eReaders, tablets, and smartphones  
3M Cloud Library ebooks are integrated into the BCCLS catalog, enabling you to search for, check out, return, and request them directly from our standard catalog.

## **THE FRIENDS OF THE LIBRARY**

Since 1991, the Friends of the H.P. Library, under the leadership of Lynne Warshavsky, have enriched the community by offering children's programs and purchasing books for the Library. Annual Friends' fundraisers include a Wine Tasting and the White Elephant Sale on the first Saturday in June. Annual programs include the holiday and summer craft programs for children. ## **FOR YOUR INFORMATION**

### **LOAN PERIOD**

All adult books and audiobooks (except high demand titles) are loaned for four weeks with two renewals if needed. Juvenile titles are loaned for two weeks with four renewals. Feature DVDS are loaned for 1 week with one renewal and NEW DVDs are loaned for three days with no renewals. Renewals can be made in person, by phone or over the Internet. Please note there is a \$2.00 per day per DVD overdue charge and a \$ .10 per day, per item overdue charge.

### **INTERNET ACCESS**

Public access to the Internet is available to library cardholders on all public access computers as well as WI-FI access in the Library.

### **PRINTING**

5 free black and white prints are available on the Library's public computers. A color copier is available for a charge of \$ .25 per page. Students may make 2 free copies if needed for a school related project.

### **FAX AND COPIER SERVICE**

The Library offers fax service at the rate of \$1.00 per page outgoing and \$.50 per page incoming. Our fax number is 201-768-7495. Photocopies are \$ .10 per page
