The site, when completed will provide 128 private rooms in addition to various high skilled medical services. The re-opening of the hospital has been a long struggle which has been well worth the effort. I want to thank all the residents of Harrington Park who supported the project.

**FORMAL COUNCILMAN SHORTAL REMEMBERED**




