PERSONEL CHANGES AT BOROUGH HALL

You are assured that these new changes will provide the continued high standard of service that we are all used to in Harrington Park.

MUNICIPAL BUDGET UPDATE 2013

The municipal budget, as presented, was introduced and approved by the Council on March 11, 2013, by a vote of 6 to 0. The public hearing and final vote will take place on Monday, April 15, 2013, in Borough hall at 7pm.

You are reminded that the **municipal portion of your property tax bill consists of between 20% to 22% of the total charge.** As we go to print, the Borough has not been advised as to the County charges or the local and regional school charges.

This year, the process is further complicated by the fact that we are in the process of completing a re-evaluation of all real property in the Borough of Harrington Park. As a result, we are unable, at this time to provide you with what the averaged assessed home in Harrington Park will see as a new tax bill.

While the Finance Committee, as well as the Mayor and Council, struggled to stay below the mandatory 2% CAP, there are budget lines that were outside the control of the Mayor and Council. These include the following: BCUA Charges, Health Benefits and Employee Contracts (negotiated in previous years).

On the *Revenue* side of the budget, you will remember that our State Aid over the years has been cut and we have not seen an increase in aid for years. In addition, the State has taken a substantial amount of funds from Energy Tax Receipts that the Borough is entitled to receive.

The full budget will be advertised in the "Record" on April 5, 2013. In addition, copies are available for your review at the Borough Hall, the Harrington Park Library as well as our website.

Your elected representatives have spent many hours trying to hold down expenses while maintaining services at a level you are accustomed to. We are hopeful that following our revaluation, conditions will improve for next year. We also look forward to policy changes coming out of Hackensack and Trenton that will help stabilize property taxes in Harrington Park.




