

PSE&G WARNS CUSTOMERS ABOUT PHONE SCAM

(Newark, NJ – Sept. 19, 2013) PSE&G is once again urging its customers to be vigilant to a telephone scam where callers threaten to shut off electric or gas service if payment is not made that day.

Residential and small business customers have reported receiving these deceptive phone calls from individuals pretending to be PSE&G employees. The callers demand that customers make a payment within hours using a Green Dot Money Pak, a type of pre-paid card available at pharmacies and convenience stores. PSE&G does not accept these cards. The utility offers a variety of payment options, and would never require a customer to use one specific type of payment.

Any customer who has doubts about the legitimacy of a call from PSE&G — especially one in which payment is requested — should call the utility directly at 1-800-436-PSEG (7734).

PSE&G customers scheduled for disconnection due to nonpayment receive written notice on their bill at least 10 days in advance. Customers who are struggling to pay their bill are encouraged to call PSE&G at 1-888-275-PSEG (7734) to learn about programs that can help.

OUR BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE AT WORK

Under the leadership of Suellen Spillane, the beautification Committee, which includes Michael Hakim, Rolf Hoerauf and myself, has been hard at work planning improvements to our town's appearance and environment.

Plantings have been completed in various parts of town. I appreciate the generous contributions made by Scott Landscaping, D'Ercole Farms and Lupardi Landscapers, as part of this project.

INSTALLATION OF THE LIGHTENING DETECTION SYSTEM

The system will also include the towns of the Northern Valley. This has been a joint effort that adds protection for those who use the fields while saving all of us a great deal of money.

All the appropriate people will be trained in how the system works. We will have a twenty mile early warning of dangerous weather conditions once the system is complete.

WINTER WEATHER TIPS



When shoveling, place the snow to the left of your driveway (facing your house) to help eliminate some of the plowed snow landing on your driveway opening.

If you have a fire hydrant on your property please keep it accessible at all times. Make sure all the snow is cleared for our Volunteer Fire Department and first responders in case of an emergency.


