



Payable to the Borough of Harrington Park
- 4) Proof of rabies vaccination for each pet being licensed - per State statute, current rabies vaccination must be valid through the end of October 2015. If the vaccination expires prior to this date your pet cannot be licensed and a late fee will be assessed each month until the rabies is renewed. If you have concerns about re-vaccinating prior to the current expiration date, please have your veterinarian contact us at 201-768-1700.
- 5) Proof of spay/neuter


