

4) **Proof of rabies vaccination for each pet being licensed** - per State statute, current rabies vaccination must be valid through the end of October 2016. If the vaccination expires prior to this date your pet cannot be licensed and a late fee will be assessed each month until the rabies is renewed. If you have concerns about re-vaccinating prior to the current expiration date, please have your veterinarian contact us at 201-768-1700.

From the Mayor's Desk....

COUNCIL REORGANIZATION

As we close our work this year, I want to thank Councilwoman Michelle Ryan for her time and dedicated service to the Borough of Harrington Park.

WINTER TIPS

As the snow season approaches, please consider the following recommendations:

When shoveling your driveway, place the snow to the left of your driveway (looking at the driveway from the street). This will eliminate most of the snow being plowed back into the apron area during street cleaning activity.

Please do not throw or plow snow back into the street once the road has been cleared. This is a dangerous and illegal activity.

Since most of our streets do not have sidewalks or curbs, consider placing reflectors near the curb line to help eliminate the plows from digging up part of your lawn. If this does happen, we will address the problem as the weather permits.

ADOPT A FIRE HYDRANT

Harrington Park has one of the best Fire Departments in all of Bergen County. They are well trained and extremely effective. Their response time is outstanding. The winter months sometimes represent problems that cause delays in the delivery of service. Following a heavy snow, consider removing the snow from around a hydrant located on or near your property. If our fireman need to shovel out the area, they lose valuable time that could result in the serious loss of life and property. Please consider helping our volunteer fire fighters better serve the community.

DOING MORE WITH LESS

During my tenure as your Mayor of Harrington Park, the number of full-time Borough Hall employees has been reduced to three people. In addition to our small full time staff, there are several part-time members of the Borough work force. 




