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Overnight Parking Waiver (4 nights or more)

REQUEST

Please read Overnight Parking Ordinance FIRST before requesting a waiver:

SECTION 1. Section 331-10(a) is hereby added to **Ordinance #331** as follows:

§ 331-10(a). No Parking — Emergency Parking Prohibition for Snow Plowing and Snow Removal.

- A. Whenever snow has fallen and the accumulation is such that it covers the roadway, an emergency shall exist and no vehicles shall be parked on any Borough street, road, highway, right-of-way or thoroughfare except in conformity with this section.
- B. Except as permitted pursuant to this chapter, no vehicles shall be parked or left unattended on any street, right-of-way or thoroughfare, until the street, road, highway, rightof-way or thoroughfare has been plowed at least one time.
- C. Any unoccupied vehicle parked or standing in violation of this section shall be deemed a nuisance and a menace to the safe and proper regulation of traffic, and any police officer may provide for the removal of such vehicle. The owner shall pay the reasonable costs of the removal and storage which may result from such removal before regaining possession of the vehicle.
- D. Unless some other penalty is expressly provided by New Jersey statute, every person convicted of a violation of this section or any supplement thereto shall be liable to a penalty of not more than \$200.00.

SECTION 2. Section 331-11 is hereby added to **Ordinance #331** as follows:

§ 331-11. Prohibited Parking; Overnight Parking. No vehicle shall be parked on any street in the Borough of Harrington Park between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m., unless an appropriate waiver has been received from the Harrington Park Police Department.

- A. Due to the narrow construction of older roadways, no overnight parking is permitted on the following municipal roads due to the safety concerns (e.g., difficulty for emergency vehicles to safely navigate) created by vehicles parked on these streets, particularly during periods of low visibility, and in some cases, due to limited (one-direction only) access: Downing Place, Martha Road, Thomas Street, Lohs Place, First Street, Second Street, Third Street, Norma Road, Florence Road (south of Harriot Avenue), Elliot Road, Carman Road, Giles Road, Parkway, Columbus Avenue, South Avenue, Semmens Road, and Ward Way.
- B. If an emergency or exigency exists that creates the need for parking on one of these streets, the Police Department may allow overnight parking on a short-term, case-by-case basis only.
- C. No permission (waiver) will be granted for overnight parking when snow or other inclement weather is expected.
- D. No permission (waiver) will be granted for overnight parking on any designated county road, which includes the following unless the Police determine that such location does not obstruct traffic visibility and is located sufficiently off pavement so as not to present any safety issues to pedestrians or vehicular traffic: Blanch Avenue, Lafayette Road, Harriot Avenue, Tappan Road, Schraalenburgh Road, Bogerts Mill Road, and Old Hook Road.
- E. Any vehicle parked overnight from 2:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m., in compliance with the abovelisted requirements, shall be parked within 100 feet of the residence/property where the vehicle owner/driver resides or is staying on a short-term basis. Vehicles must be parked in compliance with other Borough ordinances and Title 39 statutes.

F. Any resident or guest requesting an overnight parking waiver on an approved municipal roadway of more than three (3) consecutive nights must complete a request form on the Police Department website.

G. No more than two (2) vehicles per household, including guests' vehicles, may be parked on a municipal roadway.
